- BACK THIS YEAR: You must send in seeds for your Open and Fresh/Soph Field Events (Long Jump, Triple Jump, Shot Put, and Discus) to Michael Ringhauser at michael.ringhauser@yahoo.com by Sunday, April 19'th at 6pm or they will compete with the unseeded athletes. Seeded athletes should meet the minimum measurement mark listed in this entry for their event. Submission of a seed is not a guarantee that your athlete will get into the seeded flights.
- 2. 3x5 Index Cards are only needed for the High Jump, Pole Vault, and Relays. All other running events will be seeded verbally at the site. REMEMBER TO E-MAIL THE FIELD EVENT SEEDS TO MICHAEL RINGHAUSER BY THE DUE DATE!
- 3. During the meet no one is permitted on the track or at the competition areas except the athletes in their active events.
- 4. Check-in will occur on the football field and done verbally for running events and with an index card for relays.
- 5. Results will be posted at the snack shack in a timely fashion after each event.
- 6. We thank all teams that are participating and hope that everyone has a successful day of competition.

Relays: 4x100 (Open, Soph, Frosh), 4x400 (Open, Frosh/Soph), 4x800 (Open, Frosh/Soph)

Awards:

- Medals to the Top 6 finishers in ALL events.
- Plaques will be awarded to the faster OVERALL time from all sections in the open relay events. There is **not** an award for each heat.

Day of the Meet Seeding:

- 3x5 Index Cards are ONLY required for the UNSEEDED field events and ALL RELAYS. Verbal seeding will be done for all other events on-site, besides the field events needing to be e-mailed by Sunday, April 19th.
