## POLE VAULT CERTIFICATION FORM

The National Federation of State High School Associations, the governing body for high school athletics and officiating, requires Pole Vault Certification. Rule # 7-4-3 (effective 1995) states that a vaulter shall not be allowed to compete while using a pole, which has a rating of less than the vaulters actual weight. The purpose of this form is to insure that the vaulter is competing with a legal pole at each competition. A copy of this form must be presented to both the official in charge and to the meet director before each competition begins. A vaulter cannot compete without presenting this document.

It is the responsibility of the school to ensure that the pole being used is certified for the vaulter. The required signatures on this form are evidence that all parties are aware of the risks involved when an athlete competes with an illegal pole and that both the athlete and his/her pole are in compliance with the weight requirement rule.
